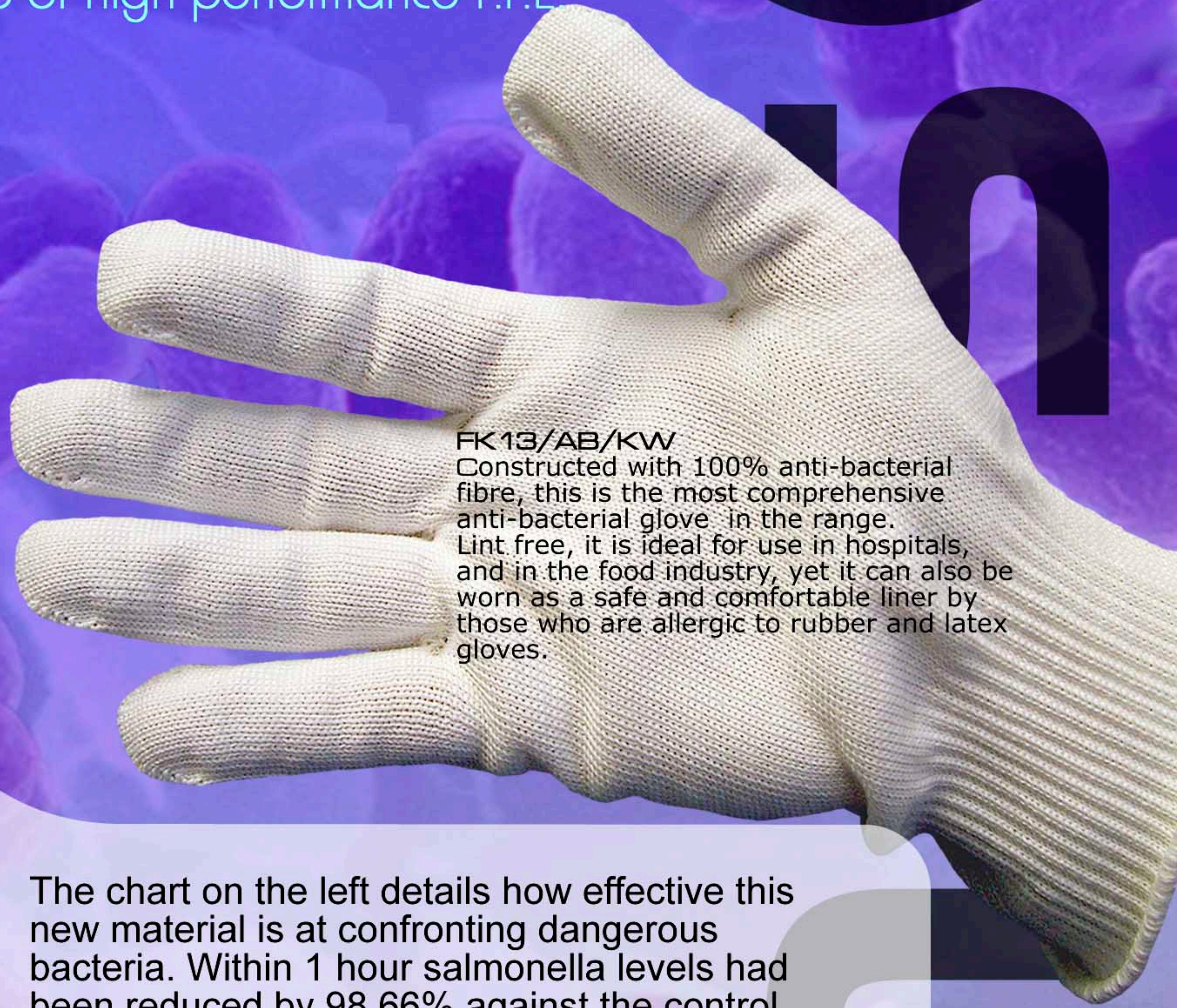

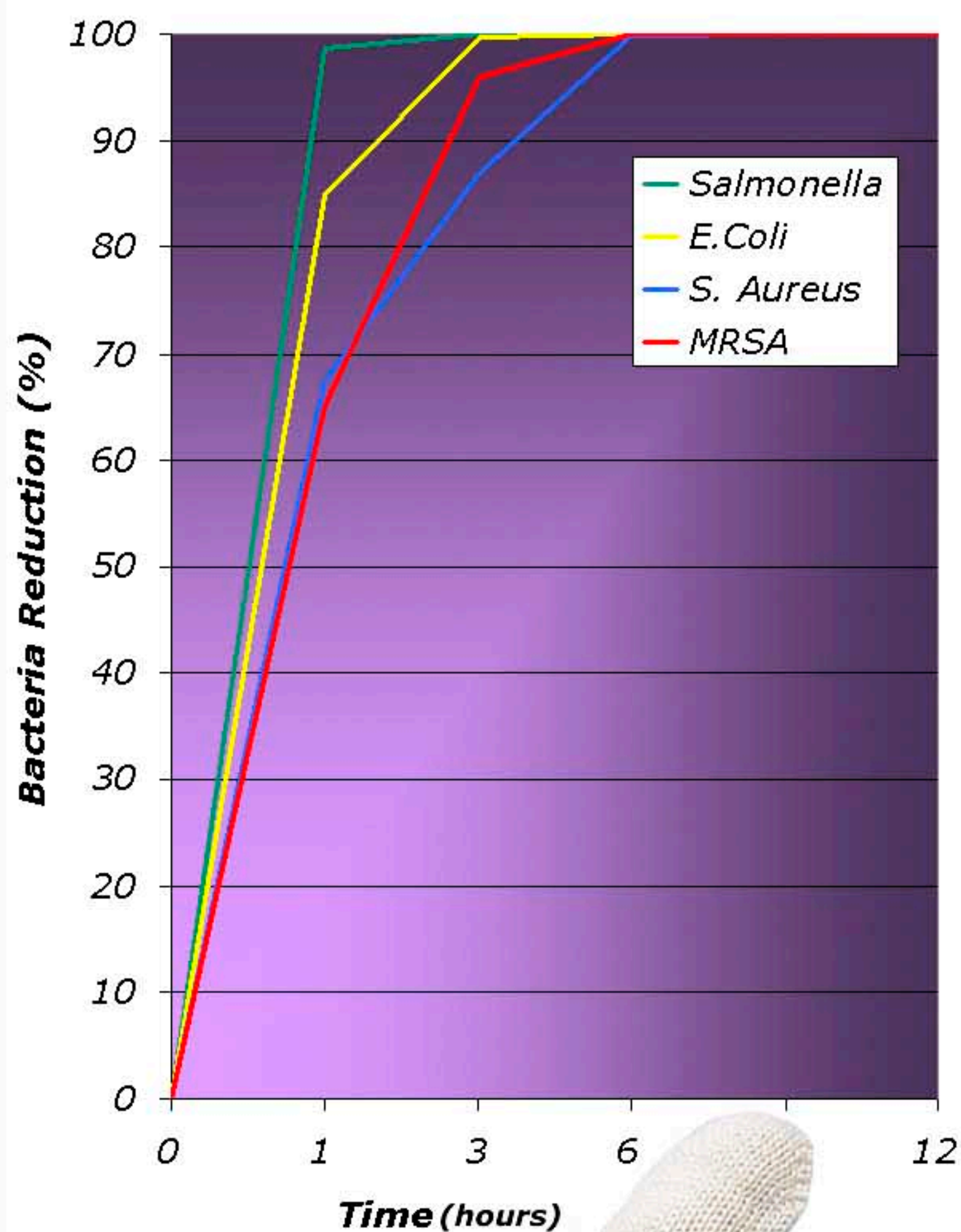

Constructed with 100% anti-bacterial fibre, this is the most comprehensive anti-bacterial glove in the range. Lint free, it is ideal for use in hospitals, and in the food industry, yet it can also be worn as a safe and comfortable liner by those who are allergic to rubber and latex gloves.

The chart on the left details how effective this new material is at confronting dangerous bacteria. Within 1 hour salmonella levels had been reduced by 98.66% against the control sample. The fibre is also particularly effective against E.Coli, S. Aureus and MRSA.

Is it safe?

Yes. Other companies use coatings or insert disinfectants (mostly chlorene phenol) into fibres to give them anti-bacterial properties. Known to migrate (reach the skin), these methods often cause allergies, are soon washed out and also have detrimental effects on our environment.

In contrast, the fibre used in our Dermos® products is inherently anti-bacterial. The active ions are homogenously spread and do not migrate. The chances of experiencing an allergic reaction is negligible and in addition, Dermos® products are washable with no loss of effect.

Viloft® is a tubular viscose staple fibre and is not only an excellent insulator against both cold and heat, but also has a first rate perspiration management system that ensures comfort. This glove is the perfect liner for other protective gloves - it provides warmth and anti-bacterial protection.

Knitted with Dyneema®, this cut resistant, lint free sleeve is ideal for use in the food industry where sharp tools are used. Anti-bacterial properties will prevent the build up and transmission of harmful bacteria such as salmonella.
